## PROFILE

Executive-producing for award winning international co-productions, Bill worked within the US Public Television system for over 22 years where he specialized in foreign co-productions and acquisitions. He subsequently headed Lark International, the consortium of PBS stations responsible for bringing the record-breaking hit *Riverdance* and Cirque de Soleil's *Allegro* to US Public Television. Bill also produced the highly successful annual *UK Immersion Seminars for Canadian Producers* for the Canadian High Commission and Telefilm; acted as a Special Advisor to the Film Commissioner of the NFB on International Broadcaster Agreements; produced and chaired panels for Banff, Reed-Midem, Real Screen and Hot Docs; and executive-produced *History Makers: the International Summit of History and Current Affairs Producers* in New York in January 2008.
